The Foundation of KIRR and It's Inaugural Assemble

In the spring of 1990, an international organizing committee was formed with 4 founder members including Hadara Daneumi —a professor of Waseda University, Japan-, who suggested the foundation of the organization first, Tsai Minshing -a profession of National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan-, Zhang Chuanfu - a professor of Central South University, China-, and professor Oh Jae-hyun. They agreed that the 1st International Symposium of Eastern Asia Resources Recycling would be held in Tokyo, Japan in November 1991 and following symposiums will be hosted every two years in the countries of the organizing committee members (in turn) in the order of seniority. According to the agreement, the second international symposium was held in Seoul in 1993. In the spring of 1991, The Korean Institute of Resources Recycling (KIRR) was first organized for the preparation of the 1st International Symposium of Eastern Asia Resources Recycling (EARTH'91) as well as for the 2nd one in Seoul. And on June 3, 1992, a resources recycling forum was held at Yonsei University for the establishment of an academic society and preparation for EARTH'93.

At last, the 2nd International Symposium of Eastern Asia Resources Recycling (EARTH'93) and the inaugural assembly of KIRR were held in Allen Hall (Yonsei University) on June 18, 1992. In the inaugural assembly where about 120 attended, the directors were elected and the purpose of the society was announced: it has the purpose of researching and developing the recovery technology of valuables from secondary resources; devoting itself to resource saving and prevention of environmental pollution; and thus contributing to human societies. The foundation of KIRR was widely covered and promoted in many daily newspapers on that day. KIRR had its office in the laboratory of material engineering (chairman Oh Jae-hyun's research office) belonging to the Department of Metallurgical Engineering, Yonsei University, and hired Hong In-ok as a staff. On October 14 of the same year, KIRR acquired permission to establish itself as corporation aggregate from Minister of Commerce and, and completed its registration in a court on October 30. On November 19, 1992, KIRR completed business registration in a tax office and received a business identification number.

It also submitted its identity as a sub-academy circle of Department of Metal to the Minister of Commerce and Industry. It was possible thanks to department head Jeong Hae-jin and section chief of steel manufacturing Hwang Woo-taek, who were in a good relationship and cooperation with us. Not long after, the supervising authority shifted to the department of industry arrangement and environment (led by department head Lee Won-gul) in the Minister of Commerce and Industry. Mr. Lee was very thoughtful and friendly. He also made a special presentation in 1992 regular general assembly (December 5, 1992) with the title of "Industrial Development and Recycling Measures". Later, he promoted up to the Vice-Minister of Commerce and Industry and became the president of Korea Electric Power Corporation.



Background: The Korean Institute of Resources Recycling (KIRR) is an academic society that teams up with domestic experts in various industries, research institutes, and universities who fully recognize the importance of resource conservation and prevention/treatment of environmental pollution by waste.

KIRR has the purpose to recognize the importance of resource recycling to the nation and society through academic and technological exchange and spread the R&D achievements of members.
